- The Budget for 2020/21 was approved. The precept application for 20/21 was accordingly set at £33.63 an increase of 1.4% on the previous year

- A bid to Guildford Council for £6600 for grant support for new toddler play equipment has been successful. With £12k still to find however ever applications for support will be progressed.
