

Surrey County Council approves funding for A247 Traffic Calming

The meeting of the Guildford Local Committee of Surrey County Council held on 13th December approved the proposal from the Highways Task force to earmark £50k for traffic calming measures on the Street and Clandon Road in West Clandon.

This represents a significant boost for those including the Parish Council who have been campaigning for safety measures on the Street for many years. Budget restrictions meant only 12 such schemes were approved this year out of 60 which had been identified by officers. At 50K the Clandon scheme is the second biggest in the budget. The Clandon scheme has been strongly supported by Surrey County Councillor Keith Taylor who chairs the Committee.

We understand the precise measures have yet to be finalised. They will be developed by officers in the New Year and based on interventions which have proved effective in other comparable locations. There will be consultation with the Parish Council in January.

In other local developments the £3k contribution to the improvement of the Green Lane extension footpath was also approved and the resurfacing of Clandon Cross Roads remains in the highways programme for next year.
